



## JobPath's STEPS TO SUCCESS Project

**J**obPath obtained federal funding for **STEPS TO SUCCESS**, a registered nursing prerequisite project. JobPath is sponsoring Pima County residents who are motivated to pursue the education and training needed to be able to apply to the Registered Nursing Program at Pima Community College (PCC). **STEPS TO SUCCESS** participants take classes together and meet bi-monthly with their counselor for peer support.

JobPath is recruiting eligible adults who have a desire to complete the PCC Registered Nursing Program pre-requisite courses to participate in a **STEPS TO SUCCESS** project cohort that will begin in January 2011.

### STEPS TO SUCCESS Eligibility Requirements:

- Minimum age 18
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Have a High School Diploma or GED
- Tucson/Pima County Resident for at least one year
- Low income — at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
- Must be able to enroll in Math 92, Writing 100 and Bio 156 in January 2011
- Have experience in a hospital or healthcare setting
