Emergency Medical Technology-Certificate

(Part-time / 1 semester program)

Learn pre-hospital emergency medical care, including physical assessment, medical techniques and ambulance operations. This program is approved by the Arizona Department of Health Services, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services towards certification as an EMT-B in the State of Arizona. Complete this program exclusively on weekdays, exclusively on evenings/weekends, or in a combination of daytime, evening and weekend classes.

JobPath Requirements

- * Financially qualify
- * Capable of studying in English
- * Resident of Pima County for 1 year
- * Minimum Age 18
- * High School Diploma or GED
- * Legally able to work in USA

Steps to take for this Job training at PCC East-Campus

1. Apply to Pima Community College.
2. Take Compass Assessment test. Must have reading score of 80.
3. Attend a new student orientation if you are a new student to PCC.
4. Contact the EMT service center at 206.7839 to obtain EMT program info.
5. Call JobPath at 520.324.0402 to schedule an orientation.
6. Attend the orientation at JobPath.
7. Call JobPath to schedule an appointment with Silvija Wilson, career counselor for a initial interview appointment @ 324.0402 x – 7004 once you have registered in the EMT program.
